TO ALL STROMBERG-CARLSON DISTRIBUTORS AND DEALERS:

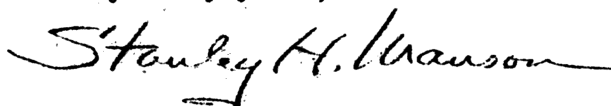
This is to advise you and members of your service organization that the Service Notes which applied to the #900 Series last season will cover the new #1000 Series Models with two exceptions; namely, #1000-H and #1000-J. Several months ago, the government froze all chassis designs and, therefore, Stromberg-Carlson's recently announced #1000 Series is actually the popular #900 Series with cabinet refinements. The Service Notes which you now have on file should be marked accordingly.
